New Business:

- Membership Approval: University of North Florida's Coastal and Marine Biology Flagship Program, submitted by Jim Gelsleichter, was previously presented by Aswani Volety to the Executive Committee and approved for presentation to SAML membership: <u>The University</u> of North Florida's Coastal and Marine Biology Flagship Program's request for membership was approved by the SAML membership by acclamation.
- **NAML President:** Attendees were reminded that Robert Dickey has been put forth as President-Elect for NAML.
- Tax-exempt status: There was discussion about the path forward for reinstating SAML's tax-exempt status. It will be independent of NAM, though NAML with remain the umbrella organization, and will be incorporated through Mississippi. Known changes will included

- obtaining independent EIN and independent tax submission. There will be follow-up on this by President Quint White and Treasurer Read Hendon.
- Budget for 2018 (see appendix 2) was presented by new treasurer Read Hendon
- **Student award list names for awards:** Attendees were charged with proposing names for the awards following Kumar Mahadevan and Margaret Davidson
- **SAML Logo contest.** \$500 prize. Mona Behl to chair the committee. Website and email will be setup by Lou Burnett. Executive Committee will select top 3 and then membership-at-large vote. There was discussion on having NAML logo updated instead of developing new logo but because of uniqueness and extent of SAML's efforts, there is justification for having SAML-specific logo. Guidelines will be provided, including background information on SAML
- Survey of SAML membership. There are plans developing for a quick survey or series of surveys to identify type of data and capabilities there are at member labs. Suggestions were to release multiple surveys that are topic specific (Physical, Chemical, Biological, Outreach, Research). This should develop into a showcase of how marine laboratories are major contributors to the body of knowledge and have a wide range of information and disciplines. Consider waiting until after Felicia Coleman's discussion to think about questions.
